Join our team

The Joint Community Rehabilitation (JCR) team is a partnership between East Sussex County Council and East Sussex Healthcare NHS Trust.

It helps people to:

- remain in their own homes and maximise their independence
- avoid going into hospital unnecessarily
- become independent as soon as possible after a stay in hospital

Along with support workers the JCR team includes a variety of other professionals who deliver specialist health and social care, including: occupational therapists, physiotherapists and nurses.

The JCR team operate 7 days a week, 7am to 10pm, including public holidays. Hours available from 18-30 hours per week including weekends.

Being a team is at the heart of JCR. We work in three teams across East Sussex including:

- Crowborough, Lewes and Peacehaven
- Eastbourne, Hailsham, Polegate and Seaford
- Bexhill, Hastings and rural Rother

Job opportunities

Support Worker

You will visit clients in their homes, helping them to regain their independence and improve their quality of life. Whilst working alongside our therapy team you will be implementing care, rehabilitation and exercise programmes. You will also support the client with personal care activities, such as washing/dressing and meal preparation.

Lead Support Worker

You will work with clients to establish the best care package to help them regain their independence and quality of life. You will identify, carry out and review agreed care plans for individuals, whilst taking on a wide variety of challenges.

Team Leader

You will be supporting the management team to ensure service quality is maintained. You will manage and support the staff group to support clients to maintain their independence at home. You will take the lead on a specialist area within the service, researching and sharing knowledge on this area and providing training to staff.
